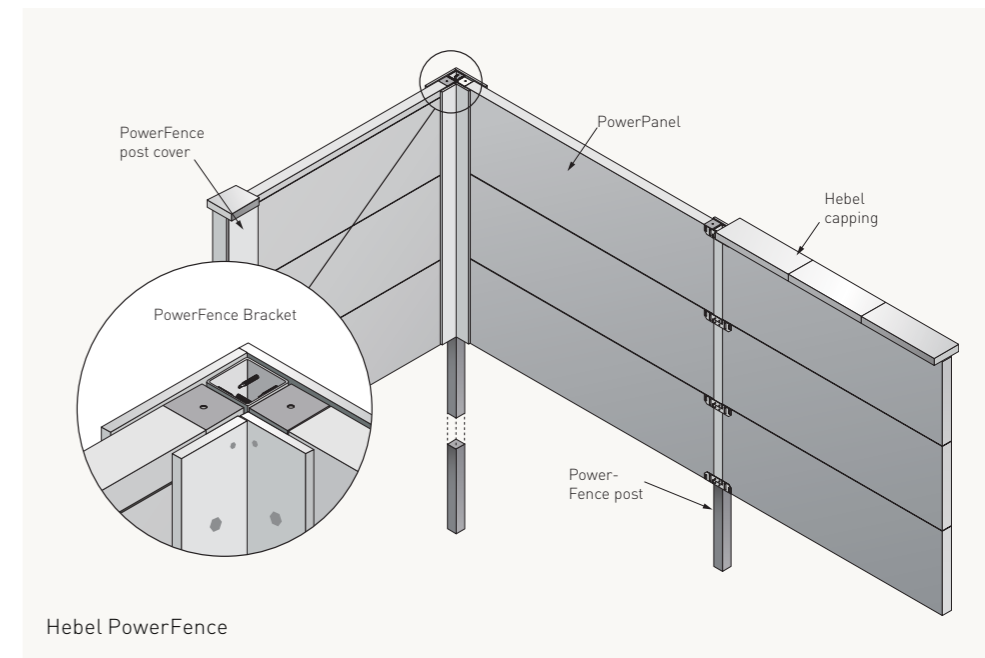

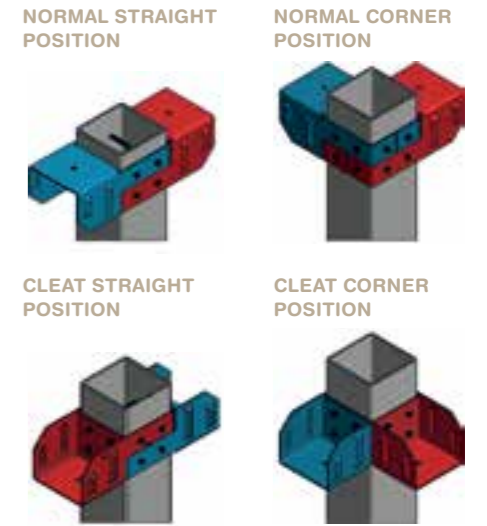
**DECORATE WITH A

The posts are simply embedded in concrete footings and brackets are screwed to the posts at the desired heights to support the panels. The 600mm wide panels are installed horizontally and are available in lengths of 1800mm and 2400mm. Panels can be stacked up to 3 high and glued to create a solid barrier up to 1800mm high. Post covers and a choice of cappings complete the fence ready for your choice of coating or render.

**THE VERSATILE HEBEL  
POWERFENCE BRACKET\***

Multi-purpose and adjustable for all-round easier and safer construction. Move it up or down while constructing. Rotate it to make a corner. Turn it upside down for a starting cleat. Use it as a lateral support for all the panels. Separate its two integrated sections for stepped or terraced fencing. Reposition and refix if need be, as you go.
